JOB SUMMARY

The Maintenance Manager is responsible for the maintenance of all equipment and machinery of a four season multi facet operation that encompasses over 350 acres of property maintained for skiing, snowboarding, tubing, cross country skiing, biking, hiking and events. This world class operation will be managed to provide safe use and excellent guest experiences in all areas and facets.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

To perform the job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential job duty and responsibility satisfactorily.

- Ability to interact and maintain positive relationships with guests, co-workers, and management and provide excellent customer service.
- Creating and maintaining operation and maintenance schedules for snowmaking equipment, grooming machines and equipment, overhead chair lifts, conveyors, and rope tow lifts.
- Creating and maintaining operation and maintenance schedules for all service vehicles and equipment.
- Developing, implementing and maintaining safety procedures and regular inspection for all lifts and equipment as directed by ANSI B.77, insurance provider, and General Manager.
- Develop and implement snow grooming plan.
- Assist Mountain Manager with snowmaking plan.
- Assist Mountain Manager with daily lift operation.
- Assist with upkeep and maintenance for all types of trails located on property.
- Assist with facility and event support as needed.
- Assist General Manager with budget decision for repair and maintenance and replacement of equipment and machinery.
- Responds quickly to all needs that may arise and communicates effectively.
- Communicate ideas or issues with Immediate Supervisor.
- Problem solve as needed, seek advice and support from Immediate Supervisor and/or Manager on Duty.
- Be energetic, motivated and possess the ability to multi-task.
- All other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- Working knowledge of electric motors and chairlift drives
- Working knowledge of diesel and small gasoline engines
- Experience operating heavy equipment and tracked machines
- Experience welding and steel repair
- Experience with pump and well operation
- Overall strong mechanical aptitude and experience working with a variety of power equipment, motors and tools.
- Light carpentry skills
- Good organizational and observation skills
- Must be able to maintain a flexible schedule, including evenings, holidays and weekends are required.
- 2-4 years' experience in a maintenance manager role
- Ability to adhere to all safety policies
- Ability to interact and maintain positive relationships with guests, co-workers and management.
- Basic computer skills

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS
